Assessment & Reporting

There will be no formal tests or assessments for students of Kindergarten and Classes 1 & 2. Assessment will be done using various formative assessment techniques and tools. Reports shall be shared with the parents, twice in an academic year.

Goals of Assessment

Assessment is two-fold in nature. In order to meet the needs of all learners, the teacher may need to differentiate the instruction. Well-planned, regular, and skillful observations help teachers gather information about children's progress over time, which ensures that the child's needs are met.

Learning Stations

A change in the setting breaks the monotony and helps to learn concepts opening up a child's mind for meaningful learning. Children can move at their pace while teachers act as facilitators. They learn to work independently, which gives the child more control over what to do. Learning stations build creativity, responsibility, and decision-making skills.



Creative Corner

Here, they can explore different art methods using clay, paints, crayons, and other craft materials available in nature helping students to think outside the box and flourish.

Language Corner

contains resources and materials for children to learn to decode letter sounds, read words, and use spelling rules to develop listening, speaking, writing, and reading skills.

Discovery Corner/ Science Lab

The lab aims to stimulate learner curiosity to explore answers. It helps build awareness around them, helping them connect to abstract concepts in science.

Math Lab

Dollhouses provide important educational benefits for intellectual and social development. Indulging in role-playing is a learning opportunity for the kids to understand life skills.
























Dance
